and

Parent Council for Deaf Education

This Memorandum of Understanding is made between the Deaf Society of NSW (DSNSW), Parramatta, NSW and Parent Council for Deaf Education (PCDE), North Rocks, NSW.

The aim of this document is to record an understanding between DSNSW and PCDE by which DSNSW and PCDE may co-operate in establishing closer links that may involve:

- Advocating for the full and equal rights of people who are deaf or hard of hearing
- Positively engaging with the diversity of the Deaf Community
- Influencing government policy in the areas of health, education and disability
- Bringing together families
- Raising community awareness of people who are deaf or hard of hearing
- Strengthening parent support networks

It is the wish of the parties that this agreement will lead to more formalised partnership agreements in relation to specific programs.
