STATEMENT OF OBJECTS

ASLIA (NSW) aims to:

1. Provide an effective support network for Auslan/English interpreters in NSW by:
 - 1.1 informing and responding to its membership regularly and in a timely manner.
 - 1.2 encouraging and supporting membership across the state of NSW.
 - 1.3 maintaining accurate records and raising funds to support the objects of the association.
 - 1.4 maintaining and continually improving its organisational structure and administrative procedures.

2. Provide continuing education, skills development and advice for our members by:
 - 2.1 providing regular and relevant professional development workshops for interpreters.
 - 2.2 providing networking support and advice to members via meetings, social events, and regular bulletins.
 - 2.3 providing financial support for members' attendance at approved professional development events.
 - 2.4 maintaining and updating a resource library.

3. Promote professional interpreting ethics and advocate for the use of professional interpreting services by:
 - 3.1 promoting compliance with the ASLIA Code of Ethics
 - 3.2 supporting and advocating for the rights of interpreters, in areas of health, professional safety and working conditions.
 - 3.3 consulting and/or collaborating with consumers and employers of Auslan/English interpreting services, and with relevant Deaf organisations.
