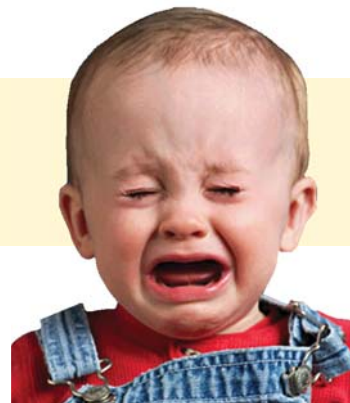




Baby Cry Alarm

Borrowing Scheme

If you are a Deaf parent you can borrow a Baby Cry Alarm from the Deaf Society of NSW



The Deaf Society has 7 Bellman brand Visit Flash Baby Cry Alarms.
Each alarm has a flashing light and bed shaker.



Who can borrow?

Deaf parents living in NSW who have a profound hearing loss. The priority is for parents of newborns.

How long can I borrow the alarm?

6 months - it's possible to extend the loan but we will need to negotiate first.

Does it cost to borrow an alarm?

You need to pay \$100 to borrow the alarm.

That is \$50 fee for loan and another \$50 security deposit. The \$50 security deposit is refunded if the alarm is returned on time, complete and in good working condition.

Are there any other costs or fees?

There is a late return fee of \$5 per day if the alarm is not returned on the date agreed. Late return fees will be deducted from the security deposit.

How do I arrange to borrow a baby cry alarm?

- Contact us to book an alarm **before** your baby is due.
- If there is an alarm available when your baby is due we register your name, address, phone/mobile/fax and email contacts and baby's due date.
- Alarms can be collected from the Deaf Society's office in Parramatta.
